


Bearings are astronomic, derived from observations on Polaris, and referred to the meridian through the centre of the respective townships.

All road allowances are one chain in width.

P. stands for D.L.S. or C.L.S. standard post; I. for old pattern iron post; Pit for four pits; 3Pits for three pits; S.M. for stone mound; Fd. for found; Tp for township; R for range; W for west; C.L.S.R. for Canada Lands Surveys Records; S.A.L.R.D. for South Alberta Land Registration District.

NOTE: For details of the relative positions of the pits and stone mounds with respect to the survey posts established by M. Wuhr see Field Book 30759, Canada Lands Surveys Records.
