



The survey represented by this plan is situated on Silver Hill, Beaver River Country, in the Mayo District, Yukon Territory, and was surveyed for The Consolidated Mining and Smelting Company, of Trail, B.C.

Bearings are astronomical and expressed in degrees and minutes.
Observed bearings are in blue.
Distances are in feet and tenths.
