Iron bars 1"x1"x36" marked "M.L.S." with marker posts are placed at all points shown thus
Survey monuments found on the ground are described and shown thus
Lands dealt with by this plan are bounded thus
Traverse lines are shown thus
Temporary stations are shown thus
