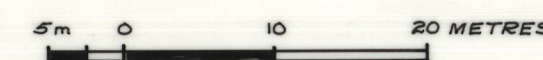

Bearings are astronomic derived from the stated bearing 80° 00' 00" for the line between found CLS 69 monuments "L8, R, 1975" on the northerly boundary of Lot 8, and "L 67, R, R, 1975" at the northwesterly corner of Lot 67 as shown on Plan 59699 C.L.S.R. and according to that plan are referred to the meridian through the northerly corner of Lot 45, shown on Plan 57839 C.L.S.R.

CLS 77 monuments placed in this survey are marked with the year of survey, appropriate lot numbers and R for Road where applicable.

Distances are in metres and decimals thereof.
